


Shimmy-Shimmy Shamrock, bright in the springtime sun,




I'm Shimmy-Shimmy Shamrock, and I love to share the story


of how St. Patrick found a clover and used it for God's glory.

the Son sent us a Helper; His name is the Holy Ghost.






I'm Shimmy-Shimmy Shamrock, and mine are lucky leaves because my fourth leaf represents the person who believes.
